WHEREAS, JCRLV 6.5 allows the Chief Judge to make "such orders as deemed
advisable" relating to local court rules and procedure; and

WHEREAS, JCRLV 34(f)(3)(B) requires a tenant filing an affidavit in answer to a
landlord's notice of eviction to include a copy of the original eviction notice, unless the tenant
signs an unsworn declaration to indicate that the notice has been lost or destroyed.

WHEREAS, the Las Vegas Justice Court is working to streamline a tenant's ability to
electronically file such an affidavit through the use of Odyssey's Guide & File capabilities which
will allow such filing remotely and without the need to come to the clerk's office.

WHEREAS, reducing the number of customers in the clerk's office to file documents is
critical to the Court's efforts to maintain proper social distancing amid the COVID-19 pandemic
and improving electronic filing capabilities advances access to justice.

WHEREAS, the current capabilities of the Odyssey Guide & File program do not enable
a tenant to attach a copy of the original eviction notice.

WHEREAS, current procedures for processing eviction cases can be amended to
alleviate the need for the tenant to include a copy of the original eviction notice.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that JCRLV 34(f)(3)(B) is hereby suspended effective
immediately.
