ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ASSOCIATE COUNSEL

Appellants have filed a motion to associate attorney Stephen Isaiah Vladeck in this appeal pursuant to SCR 42. Attached to the motion to associate Mr. Vladeck is a verified application, certificates of standing from the Supreme Court of Texas, the Supreme Court Appellate Division of New York, and the District of Columbia; and a statement pursuant to SCR 42 from the State Bar of Nevada. The State Bar of Nevada's Rule 42 statement indicates that Mr. Vladeck has not previously applied to appear in Nevada courts within the past 3 years. *See* SCR 42(6) (stating that repeated appearances by any person pursuant to this rule shall be cause for denial of the motion). Accordingly, the motion to associate is granted. SCR 42(8). Mr. Vladeck shall be permitted to appear on behalf of appellants in this matter. Nevada attorney Maurice B. VerStandig of the VerStandig Law Firm, LLC, shall be responsible for all matters presented by Mr. Vladeck in this matter. *See* SCR 42(14)(a) (requiring the Nevada attorney of record to be responsible for and actively participate in the representation of a client in these proceedings); NRAP 25(a)(5) (requiring all documents submitted to the supreme court for filing to include the original signature of at least one attorney of record who is an active member of the State Bar of Nevada);

NRAP 46(a)(3) (requiring Nevada counsel to sign all briefs, be present during oral argument, and be responsible for all briefs and matters presented by foreign counsel).

It is so ORDERED.
